**Enrollment fee is applied to the student's account upon official start at the College, and is refundable within 5 days of enrolling should the student decide to cancel.

Full Time Schedule (35): Tuesday – Saturday, 9:30am to 5:00pm

Part Time Schedule (24): Tuesday – Friday, 5:30pm to 9:30pm; Saturday, 8:30am – 5:00pm

Transfer students are charged for percent of course to be completed.

Example: Student has 350 hours in the Full Course Program from a previous school, and is enrolling at Beau Monde College of Hair Design in the Full Course Program.

$2300 - 350 = 1950$ Hours left to complete

1950 divided into $2300 = 84.87\%$, which would round up to 85% .

Therefore, the student would be charged 85% of the lab fee. The registration fee, and the kits and books are non-proratable charges. All transfer students must have an official academic transcript from prior school to receive credit for those hours.

Students not applying for financial assistance will be required to make a deposit of at least 10% of the tuition, full cost of kits and books, in addition to the $\$100$ enrollment fee.
